#### Study Through 1 Corinthians

Last Sunday, we concluded a 19-month study through the Gospel of Mark. Today, we will begin our study in the book of 1 Corinthians, with an introduction from the book of Acts, Chapter 18. 1 Corinthians continues to be timely for the church today, both to instruct and to inspire. Christians are still powerfully influenced by their cultural environment, and most of the questions and problems that confronted the church at Corinth are still very much with us—problems like immaturity, instability, divisions, jealousy and envy, lawsuits, marital difficulties, sexual immorality and misuse of spiritual gifts. Yet in spite of this concentration on problems, Paul's letter contains some of the most familiar and beloved chapters in the entire Bible, such as chapter 13 (on love) and chapter 15 (on resurrection). #### Call To Worship: Psalm 19

Of Psalm 19, C. S. Lewis wrote, “I take this to be the greatest poem in the Psalter and one of the greatest lyrics in the world.” It has been set to music often, notably by Schütz, Bach, & Haydn. Contemporary artists still find in it a rich source of inspiration. Psalm 19 is considered a Wisdom Psalm, a unified expression of a man's response to God's revelations in nature, in His Word and in His provision for
