What Is Advent?

We are a people of promise. For centuries, God prepared people for the coming of his Son, our only hope for life. At Christmas we celebrate the fulfillment of the promises God made-that he would give a way to draw near to him. Advent is what we call the season leading up to Christmas. It begins four Sundays before December 25. The lighting of these candles reminds us of the promise that a Light would come to the World: "The people that walked in darkness have seen a great light: they that dwell in the land of the shadow of death, upon them hath the light shined" (Isaiah 9.2). Each candle brings us closer to the time when we recall His birth as well as His Second Coming. Remembering Jesus' parable in Matthew 25:1-13, the Parable of the Ten Virgins, we also seek to be wise and have our lamps ready for the Bridegroom who is coming again. As Jesus said: "Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming" (25:13). As we worship our Lord Jesus and recall His first coming, look forward to His Second Coming, let us also be attentive to His present coming. May the Lord use this season to draw you and your family closer to Him, that you may know His presence and hear His voice in a fresh way. (Sources: Desiring God & Faith for Living)
