Gladly Would I Leave Behind Me

This beautiful hymn, featured on the Sovereign Grace Music Album, *From Age to Age*, is based on a poem by Anne Griffiths (1776 – 1805), a Welsh farmer's wife who died giving birth to her first child at the age of 29. She left behind a small collection of poetry that is regarded as a high point of Welsh literature. The hymn conveys a simple, yet poignant message: as Christians, the desire to lay aside everything in order to gain Christ is a thought that should echo in everything we think and do. Ann's words capture that thought beautifully:

*Gladly would I leave behind me all the pleasure I have known
To pursue surpassing treasures at the throne of God the Son
Worthy of unending worship, love and loveliness is He
By His precious death were millions, from the jaws of death set free*
